<p>What are you allowed to do with the product?</p>	<p><u>You are free to:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  Use the product for your internal technical evaluation.  Create value added product (e.g. mosaic) and derivative work (e.g. map, report) for your internal technical evaluation. <p><u>You may not :</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  Distribute, sell and otherwise make available the product nor value added product to third parties.
<p>What should you watch out for?</p>	<p>You are not buying the product, you are granted the right to use the product.</p> <p> Only do what is expressly permitted under the Airbus Technical Evaluation Licence and ensure Copyright credits are conspicuously displayed.</p> <p>Make sure to inform Airbus of the results of your evaluation.</p>
